Approval of minutes:

Minutes of the February meeting were approved.

Committee charge –The committee charge was reviewed by the present members of ATAC and the general consensus is supportive of the change with some minor adjustments.

- Meredith will have a meeting next week with the Vice President of Finance and Administration and other capitol planning members to discuss the change in committee structure. If all goes well then the change will go forward.
- If ATAC members are interested in serving on the committee then tell Meredith so she can mention it to the vice president who will be making the appointments.

Bike Friendly University App-The committee reviewed the information that Alaina was able to gather and input into the new application tool. Suggestions for short response and additional information were given. Alaina will have a completed draft to present to ATAC at the next meeting.

Bike parking spring survey – maybe this would be too much and we should focus on the BFU application. There are some concerns with spring counts, since April is more rainy than October. For repeatable dates, fall would likely be better.

Safe driving tip – the group gave feedback to Meredith about the draft document. CAMPO's Drive Your Bike publication might be a good place to look for additional tips or ideas. Meredith met with Peer Health Advocates and is coordinating these efforts with them. The goal is to develop something campus specific. We should get the Public Safety bike safety videos on the TO website on the bike safety page. The group made a series of suggestions and Meredith will make changes.
