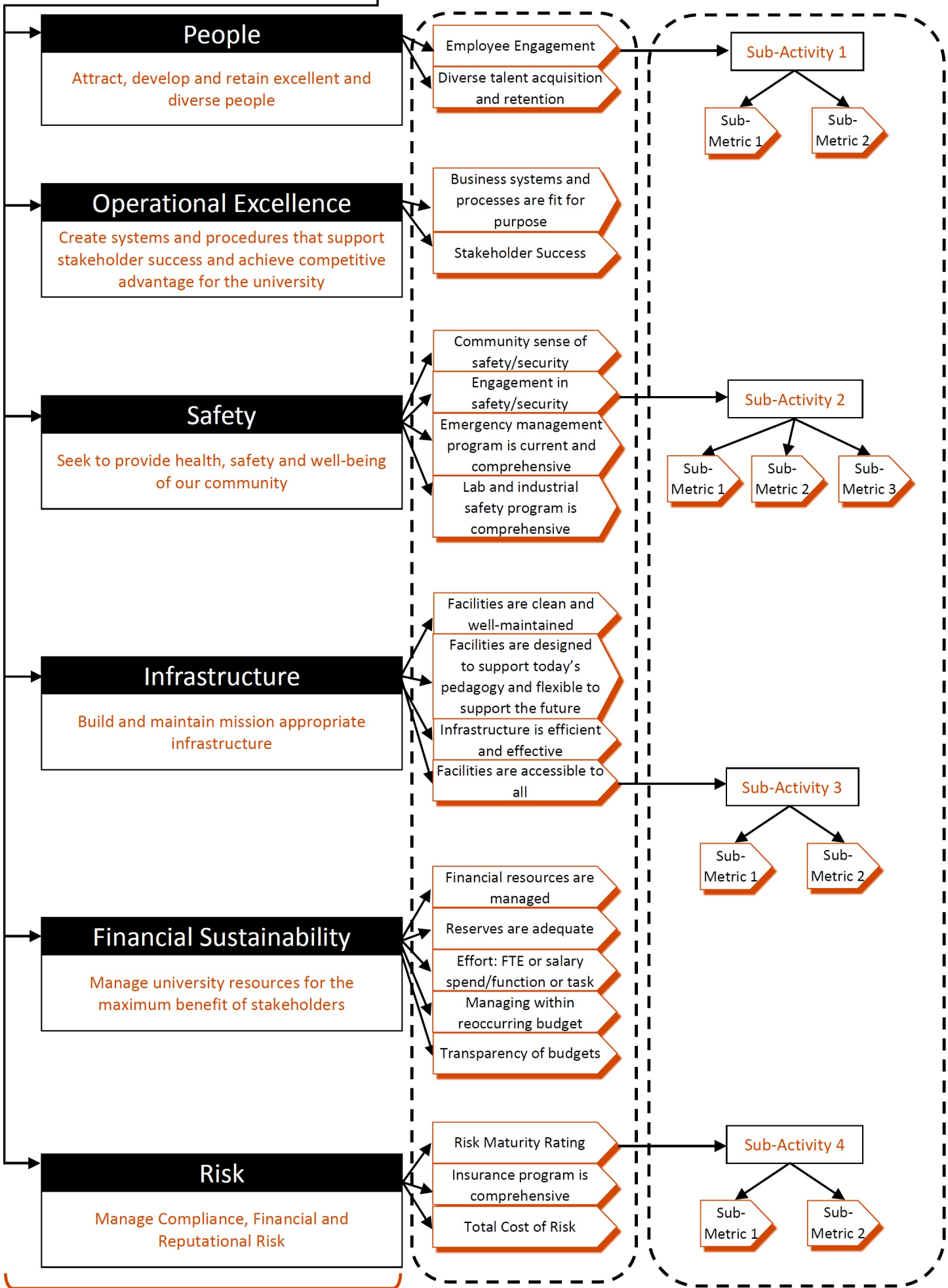


The DFA Principles are rules that guide our judgement making and action taking. They reflect how we conduct our work and treat our partners.



Key Performance Indicators (KPIs in white text) operationalize the Framework by representing the state of affairs within DFA by integrating performance measurements of key activities.

Each KPI has been assigned an overarching key activity (in orange text) that represents how all of DFA will focus efforts to improve that KPI.

The DFA metrics are performance measurements tied to the KPI and key activity.

At the unit level, teams will select the DFA metrics that best measure how they contribute towards DFA's success. Sub-activities describe how the team will work to improve the metric. This work will be measured by the team's sub-metrics.
